

**FACT SHEET**  
**NATO EXHIBITION, BUCHAREST SUMMIT**  
**“Securing Our Future”**

In the run-up to and during the NATO Summit in Bucharest in April, NATO will exhibit a multimedia display entitled “**Securing Our Future**”. The exhibition, which highlights NATO’s role in responding to existing and emerging security challenges, will be open to the public for two weeks in Bucharest, and will then be displayed at the Summit venue.

**Content**

A combination of print, photographic, video and interactive media, the exhibit outlines the Alliance, its current operations, developing capabilities and partnerships.

The exhibition is produced in English and French, NATO’s two official languages, with components in Romanian.

An additional module detailing NATO’s role in defence against terrorism will be on display uniquely at the Summit venue.

- **15 units** will inform visitors about the Alliance, including:
  - **6 video screens** presenting films, images and text
  - **2 touchscreens** presenting an interactive NATO quiz and a selection of 10 “Afghanistan stories”, respectively
  - **1 distribution unit** which will offer take-home multimedia products, e.g. a DVD version (virtual tour) of all exhibition content
- A **projection** of short films about NATO will accompany the exhibit, including the following titles (which will also be available on DVD):

  - “Afghanistan: Five years of change”

- At the Summit venue, a separate exhibition module entitled “Defence Against Terrorism” will complement the main exhibition, providing a more detailed look at the Alliance’s added value in the fight against terrorism
